Swimming in the Cooler Weather

The major benefit of swimmers staying **water active** throughout the cooler months is that it will enhance their summer swimming. It also reinforces the learning process and continues the development of their swimming skills. We are lucky to have heated pool water 28.5 degrees, please remember that all Kirby swimmers also have full access of the change room facilities, including the warm showers.

Warm clothing to change into, even a beanie and perhaps a warm drink can help reduce the impact of getting out of the water. Having 2 towels available for drying swimmer is advised. Often it is the parents that feel the elements waiting for their children's lesson to finish, we suggest that you rug up and bring a hot drink to keep you warm on the inside. - Please source an enrolment form on your swimming day from the CCGS office if you do not receive it earlier.
- Your form MUST be completed and returned ON THE DAY with payment details included.

GUIDELINES REGARDING MAKE UP SESSIONS

- Make up sessions are only available if there are vacancies or absentees within a class
- Please call us to inform us if you will be absent or your child is sick.
- We will never overload our classes to cater for make up sessions and compromise our quality.
- Please call on a daily basis, on the day you are wanting the make up session, to check the availability
